Basic Info:

All 48 teams will be divided into brackets of 4 teams each. For each bracket there will be a round robin and all teams will play each other – 3 matches total. Based on the results of the bracket play teams will advance to either a Gold, Silver, Bronze, or Copper Draw. Within each draw will be an additional 2-4matches, win or lose. There will be a minimum of 5 matches total for every team at this event based on the expected 48 total teams.

1st and 2nd place teams from the Gold bracket of this tournament will receive automatic bids to the 2015 Tennis On Campus National Championship.

Each school may enter up to two teams. Each team can consist of up to (10) total players. A minimum of (2) males and (2) females are required per team.

Entry Fees:

\$225.00 per Team. Fee is <u>non-refundable</u> after September 19th.

- Player Party Dinner Saturday Oct. 11th

Team Expenses:

Each college/team will be expected to pay for all expenses incurred by the school. **Recommended lodging** is hosted at the **Hilton Head Marriott Resort and Spa** and at the **Red Roof Inn Hilton Head Island** but each team is responsible for making their own reservations and for the cost of hotel stay.

Awards: All finalists for Gold, Silver, and Bronze brackets will receive an award.
