

### Tournament Format

Round Robin Pool Play (16 pools of 4 teams each. Top team from each pool advance to gold division, second place team advance to the silver division, third place team in pool goes to the bronze division and fourth place team to the cooper division.

### Scoring

World Team Tennis format can be found on the back of each scorecard.

### On-Court Disputes

Call in the umpire, discuss your protest. Settled by USTA Umpire. Umpire decision is final.

### Venues

All matches will be played at Cary Tennis Park and Godbold Park in Cary, North Carolina. The National Championship match will on center court at the Cary Tennis Park.

### Team Sportsmanship Award

Will be awarded to the team that participates in the true spirit of the sportsmanship ideal. The captain's from each team will be asked to cast a vote for the team that best exemplifies and exhibits fundamental values such as respect, fairness, civility, honesty and responsibility. These votes will be considered along with the votes from the "Awards Panel" to determine the honorees.


